### BVI Market Overview

- ►GDP: USD\$1.1 1.2B
- ▶GDP Growth: Averaged 4.4% per annum 2010-2017
- ▶Per Capita Income: US \$35,000
- ► Currency: USD
- ► Main Industries Tourism and Financial Services



## BVI Market Overview

- Construction Sector: \$30M \$50M annually
- ►ICT: \$55M annually
- ► Construction usually accounts for 3-5% of GDP, but 9-10% of employed persons
- ► Taxes
- ▶Safety and Stability






# Business opportunities for Trinidad & Tobago exporters

  - Based on complexity or project size
- Government
  - well established tendering process
  - actively encourages partnering with international firms for major projects



# Business opportunities for Trinidad & Tobago exporters

- Main areas for growth and development
  - ► ICT, renewable energy, and tourism, education and other general infrastructure
- Private sector
  - Bitter End, Peter Island, Mosquito Island, Blunder Bay, Oil Nut Bay, Biras Creek, Norman Island, YCCS Yacht Club
- \$3.6B damage done by Hurricane Irma
- Strong AAA rated Insurance Providers







### Post Hurricane Projects

The Recovery Development Agency (RDA) has primary oversight over recovery projects following Hurricane Irma & Maria <a href="https://bvirecovery.vg/">https://bvirecovery.vg/</a>

### Examples of projects:

- Elmore Stoutt High School Redevelopment Project – currently accepting pre-qualification bids from local and international firms
- Re-building of the Government Central Administration Complex recently awarded
- West End Ferry Terminal







# Examples of Government Projects

- Capital Improvement programme for the Terrance B. Lettsome International Airport
- Expansion and reorganisation of BVIPA's cargo port systems, including the erection of a general cargo warehouse.
- Enhance the security of the Government's IT infrastructure and functional enhancements to the Water and Sewerage billing system.
- Digitization of Government Services



### Review of the market conditions for foreign service providers

- Bidding on publicly advertised projects
- Establish functional relationships
- Local Service Providers are ALWAYS looking for strategic partnerships and aliances
- Word of mouth, and reputational strength are dominant drivers of market share.
- BVI firms have indicated an interest in collaborating on contracts
  - Greater preference for U\$\$10M to U\$\$50M range





# Pricing trends in the marketplace

#### Labour

- Labourer: \$80 -\$100
- Tradesman:e.g. Carpenteror Mason \$120- \$150
- Foreman: Around \$170

#### Material

• Steel/Rebar -\$1,200 per ton; sand \$85 per cubic yard; Ready-mix Concrete - \$180 per cubic yd 5000 psi mix; Untreated ply -\$1,600.00 per bundle

#### Equipment

Excavator-\$1800; Backhoe \$600; Crane Truck \$1,500.00 - \$3,000 depending on size;

# Logistics in the British Virgin Islands

- Main port Port Purcell, Road Town, Tortola
- ▶ Duty 0 20% of CIF
- ► Wharfage: 2% of CIF
- ► Shipping lanes
- ▶ Time to clear goods
- ▶ FCL and LCL options
- ► Air freight and sea freight options
